Governance of maritime spaces: EEZ and beyond – till the outer limit of the continental shelf. *Marine strategy for the next decade*: old and new challenges (especially what's new?). *Resources for observation, monitoring and surveillance of the sea*: from the water column to the atmosphere. *Overarching goal*: transforming our world by reversing ocean degradation. *2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development*: prevent and significantly reduce all kinds of marine pollution, including marine debris and nutrient pollution; minimise and address the impacts of ocean acidification; effectively regulate and end illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing, and implement science-based management plans; ensure that at least 10% of the coastal and marine area is fully protected; increase scientific knowledge and develop research capacity; ensure the restoration, conservation and long-term resilience of marine ecosystems.
